Purpose / Background

- Based on the direction of City Council at their February 26, 2019 Study Session, City staff is bringing forth a draft letter of support for the evaluation of a designation of E-470 as a Hazardous Materials (“HazMat”) route and a draft letter of opposition to the designation.

Criteria to Consider

- Per the City Attorney, a vote will need to occur for the City to issue a formal letter. This can be done by Resolution and it can authorize the Mayor to evidence the position by sending a letter.

Staff Recommendation

- City staff recommends that City Council move forward with a vote on whichever Resolution and accompanying letter it determines best ensures that those they serve are benefited.
