## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, RE-APPOINTING WILLARD B. HARDESTY AS THE DEPUTY MUNICIPAL JUDGE AND SETTING COMPENSATION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 8.2(B) of the City of Brighton Charter, the City Council is charged with the responsibility of appointing, by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members in office, a presiding Municipal Judge and such Deputy Municipal Judges as the Council deems necessary; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 8.2(C) of the City of Brighton Charter, each Municipal Judge shall be appointed for a two (2)-year term; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2016-108 was passed on November 1, 2016, re-appointing the Honorable Willard B. Hardesty Deputy Municipal Judge for a two (2)-year term; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 8.2(D) of the City of Brighton Charter, Council shall establish the compensation for the Deputy Municipal Judge; and

WHEREAS, the City Council reviewed the performance of Willard B. Hardesty on March 12, 2019, and found it to be satisfactory.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO:

<u>Section 1</u>. Willard B. Hardesty is hereby re-appointed the Deputy Municipal Judge for the Brighton Municipal Court for a two (2)-year term ending March 31, 2021, or as soon as practical thereafter.

<u>Section 2</u>. As Deputy Municipal Judge, Willard B. Hardesty shall be paid compensation at the rate of \$92.75 per hour with benefits.

<u>Section 3.</u> As Deputy Municipal Judge, Willard B. Hardesty shall be eligible for any and all benefits available to other full-time employees of the City of Brighton.
