*WHEREAS*, the full benefits of planning requires public officials and citizens who understand, support, and demand excellence in planning and plan implementation; and

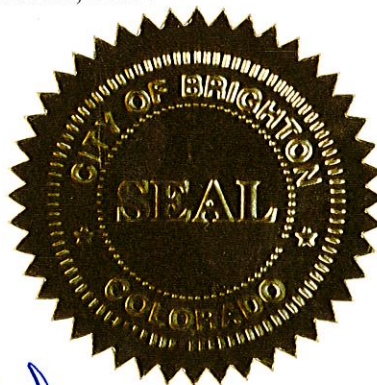
*WHEREAS*, the month of October is designated as National Community Planning Month throughout the United States of America and its territories; and
