IGA Summary

Census Liaison Position

"The position has and will serve as a primary contact and coordinator for Adams County's efforts related to the 2020 Census, which includes the implementation and coordination of activities, branding, messaging, and stakeholder engagement, all to ensure the most complete count in Adams County."

IGA Outlines responsibilities of Adams County and the City.

- City agrees to participate/coordinate in county initiatives
- Pay a one-time proportionate share of the position costs
