

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-127

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACCEPTING THE BID OF ATOZ RECREATION AND AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR PLAYGROUND IMPROVEMENTS AT VETERANS PARK, PROJECT #19-029.1, TO ATOZ RECREATION IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY FIVE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY FIVE DOLLARS (\$185,725.00), AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY AND THE CITY CLERK TO ATTEST THERETO

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton, Colorado (“City”), published a notice inviting proposals through its formal RFP process for Playground Improvements Veterans Park, Project #19-029.1 (“Project”); and

WHEREAS, funding will be approved in the 2020 Parks and Recreation Capital budget for the Project; and

WHEREAS, AtoZ Recreation submitted a proposal for the Project which has been reviewed by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City believes that AtoZ Recreation is the most responsive and responsible proposer for the Project; and

WHEREAS, at the November 5, 2019 Brighton City Council Meeting the City Council required a bid from AtoZ Recreation to include poured-in-place surfacing instead of engineered wood fiber surfacing for the playground and the bid to be presented to City Council on December 3, 2019, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 17.7 of the City of Brighton Charter, “The Council shall establish by ordinance procedures requiring competitive bidding for contracts for the procurement of services, equipment, and supplies;” and

WHEREAS, Article 3-8 of the Brighton Municipal Code sets forth the requirements and procedures for purchasing supplies or services and contracting for public works or professional services.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The bid of AtoZ Recreation, in an amount of One Hundred Eighty Five Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty Five Dollars (\$185,725.00), is hereby accepted.

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to sign the contract on behalf of the City, and the City Clerk to attest thereto.

Section 3. All resolutions or parts of resolutions of the City in direct conflict herewith are hereby rescinded.
