A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, APPROVING THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR SHARING THE COST OF A CENSUS LIAISON POSITION IN ADAMS COUNTY AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID IGA ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton, Colorado ("City") desires to enter into this Intergovernmental Agreement ("IGA") with Adams County and the cities of Arvada, Commerce City, Federal Heights, Northglenn, Thornton, Westminster, and the Town of Bennet (collectively, the "Parties") to share the cost of funding a Census Liaison position ("Position") in Adams County; and

WHEREAS, the IGA is intended to address the contribution of a proportionate share of funding for the Position to support the City in coordination efforts for the upcoming Census 2020 count; and

WHEREAS, the Parties intend to fund the Position for two years from April of 2019 through April of 2021; and

WHEREAS, the total two-year cost of the Position is estimated to be one hundred twenty-four thousand dollars (\$124,000.00) with the City's prorated share not to exceed seven thousand dollars (\$7,000.00).

WHEREAS, pursuant to §29-1-203, et seq., of the Colorado Revised Statutes, governmental entities are authorized and encouraged to cooperate by contracting with one another to share in the costs of services or functions for their mutual benefit; and

WHEREAS, City Council believes this action to be in the best interest of the citizens of Brighton and the surrounding areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The Intergovernmental Agreement for Sharing the Cost of a Census Liaison Position is hereby approved.
- <u>Section 2</u>. The Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute and deliver such agreement on behalf of the City in substantially the form presented at this meeting with such technical additions, deletions and variations as the City Attorney may deem necessary or appropriate and not inconsistent with this Resolution.
