- The City Council has adopted Resolution NO. 03-14, establishing a policy for the naming of Public amenities and park and recreation facilities in the City of Brighton, including the procedure for selecting names for recognition on the Memorial Parkway.
- The City Clerk has received a petition requesting the recognition of Dick and Mary Hodge for their service to the Brighton Community.
- The Parks and Recreation Advisory Board reviewed the Petition at their meeting on November 6, 2019 and determined that the Petition properly meets all the relevant criteria established by the Naming Policy.
- The Parks and Recreation Advisory Board held a public meeting on December 6, 2019 and unanimously approved a motion Recommending that Dick and Mary Hodge be recognized for their service to the Brighton Community by placing a plaque on the Memorial Parkway.
