

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, DIRECTING THE ACTING CITY MANAGER TO PRESENT AT A FUTURE STUDY SESSION A DRAFT PROPOSAL FOR ALLOWING THE KEEPING OF GOATS IN THE CITY OF BRIGHTON

WHEREAS, the City received a neighborhood petition from a resident requesting that the Council allow her to keep goats on her residential property; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code does not currently allow goats to be kept on residential properties; and

WHEREAS, members of the City Council expressed a desire to have this subject presented at a regular meeting to record a formal vote and provide clear direction to the staff and provide an opportunity for the public to provide input; and

WHEREAS, a draft proposal presented at an upcoming Study Session will allow City Council to provide input about specifics that should or should not be included in any ultimate legislation for allowing the keeping of goats.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Acting City Manager is directed to present at a future Study Session a draft proposal for allowing the keeping of goats in the City of Brighton.
