

RESOLUTION NO: 2020-88

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACCEPTING THE BID OF GARNEY COMPANIES, INC. AND AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT EXPANSION AND DENITRIFICATION – CONSTRUCTION MANAGER AT RISK, PROJECT #20-006280, TO GARNEY COMPANIES, INC. FOR THE CONTRACT AMOUNT OF \$369,068.00 (THREE HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE THOUSAND SIXTY-EIGHT DOLLARS), AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO SIGN THE CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY AND THE CITY CLERK TO ATTEST THERETO

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton, Colorado (“City”), published a notice inviting bids through its formal bid process for WATER TREATMENT PLANT EXPANSION AND DENITRIFICATION – CONSTRUCTION MANAGER AT RISK, Project #20-006280 (“Project”); and

WHEREAS, sufficient appropriation exists for the Project; and

WHEREAS, GARNEY COMPANIES, INC. submitted a bid for the Project which has been reviewed by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City believes that GARNEY COMPANIES, INC. is the most responsive and responsible bidder for the Project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 17.7 of the City of Brighton Charter, “The Council shall establish by ordinance procedures requiring competitive bidding for contracts for the procurement of services, equipment, and supplies;” and

WHEREAS, Article 3-8 of the Brighton Municipal Code sets forth the requirements and procedures for purchasing supplies or services and contracting for public works or professional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The bid of GARNEY COMPANIES, INC. is hereby accepted.

Section 2. The City Manager, or Designee, is hereby authorized to sign the contract on behalf of the City, and the City Clerk to attest thereto.

Section 3. All resolutions or parts of resolutions of the City in direct conflict herewith are hereby rescinded.
