**PURPOSE:**

To approve resolution setting the property tax mill levy for 2017 at 6.65 mills.

**BACKGROUND/HISTORY:**

The City Council has adopted the 2018 Budget, and the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating purposes from property tax revenue is \$2,687,900.

Preliminary net assessed values by the Adams and Weld County Assessors are \$380,587,100 and \$23,611,720, respectively.

The mill levy of 6.65 will be certified to both Adams and Weld Counties and collected as general property taxes in 2018.

**CRITERIA BY WHICH COUNCIL MUST CONSIDER THE ITEM:**

Any increase to the mill levy requires a public vote.

**OPTIONS FOR COUNCIL'S CONSIDERATION:**

Staff is recommending no change to the mill levy.
