#### **PURPOSE**

To approve a resolution setting forth certain fees and charges assessed by the City of Brighton for 2020.

#### BACKGROUND

The City Council must annually adopt a resolution setting forth certain fees and charges for the City of Brighton. The attached resolution outlines the recommended fees and charges for 2020.
