PURPOSE

To approve a resolution setting the property tax mill levy for 2019 at 6.65 mills.

STRATEGIC FOCUS AREA

BACKGROUND

The City Council has adopted the 2020 Budget, and the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating purposes from property tax revenue is \$3,406,545.

The mill levy of 6.65 will be certified to both Adams and Weld Counties and collected as general property taxes in 2020.

CRITERIA BY WHICH COUNCIL MUST CONSIDER THE ITEM

Any increase to the mill levy requires a public vote.
