### **PURPOSE**

With the arrival of new City Council members and as a refresher for existing City Council members, the Infrastructure Department/Utilities Division would like to provide information regarding the City's water rights and water acquisition process. This is a critical component of the City's overall water system and supports the City's ability to provide potable drinking water to the community and sustain growth. Important decisions from Council will be required in the coming months and years, and this presentation is intended to provide critical background information, so that informed decisions can be made.
