

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-35

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF TYLER TECHNOLOGIES, INC. AND APPROVING THE PROCUREMENT OF THE BRIGHTON POLICE DEPARTMENT RECORDS MANAGEMENT SYSTEM FOR THE CONTRACT AMOUNT OF SEVEN HUNDRED THIRTY-FOUR THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED FORTY DOLLARS (\$734,340), AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton's (the "City's") police department ("BPD") currently participates in a shared records management system ("RMS") hosted by Adams County Communications Center ("AdCom"); and

WHEREAS, AdCom has decided it will no longer be hosting the shared RMS platform; and

WHEREAS, the BPD desires to obtain its own standalone RMS platform because if it does not obtain its own RMS platform, then the BPD will assume full costs under the current AdCom model while continuing to operate on a platform with limited functionality, increasing risk related to system reliability, data access, and long-term vendor support; and

WHEREAS, the City published a notice inviting bids through its formal bid process for the Brighton Police Department Records Management System, Project No. 25-009042 (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, sufficient appropriations exist for the Project; and

WHEREAS, Tyler Technologies, Inc. ("Tyler") submitted a bid for the Project in the amount of \$734,340 ("Proposal"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes Tyler is the most responsive and responsible bidder for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the procurement followed Article 3-8 of the Brighton Municipal Code and the requirements and procedures for contracting public works or professional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Proposal of Tyler is hereby approved.

Section 2. The City Manager, after consultation with the City Attorney, is hereby authorized to sign the contract with Tyler in an amount of \$734,340 for the Project on behalf of the City.

Section 3. This Resolution is effective as of the date of its adoption.
