

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-100

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, APPROVING THE PLACEMENT OF A PLAQUE ON LEGACY PATHWAY RECOGNIZING KEN KREUTZER FOR HIS SERVICE TO THE BRIGHTON COMMUNITY

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2023-136, establishing a policy for the naming of public amenities and parks and recreation facilities in the City of Brighton (the "City"), including the procedure for selecting names for recognition on the Legacy Pathway (the "Naming Policy"); and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk has received a petition, submitted pursuant to and in accordance with the Naming Policy, requesting recognition of Ken Kreutzer for his service to the Brighton community (the "Petition"); and

WHEREAS, Ken Kreutzer served on the City Council, taught at Brighton High School, and called the football games for the Brighton Bulldogs for 25 years; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board (the "Board") has reviewed the Petition, and has found and determined that the Petition meets all of the necessary requirements of the Naming Policy; and

WHEREAS, the Board, at a meeting on September 4, 2024, recommended that Ken Kreutzer be recognized for his service to the City with a plaque on Legacy Pathway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A plaque shall be placed on the Legacy Pathway recognizing Ken Kreutzer for his service to the City.

Section 2. This Resolution is effective as of the date of its adoption.
