A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, APPROVING THE DONATION OF FUNDS AS APPROPRIATED IN THE 2026 BUDGET AND FINDING A PUBLIC PURPOSE FOR THE USE OF THOSE FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Brighton (the "City") supports the community through donations to nonprofits that provide direct services or other cultural and useful benefits to the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has set aside funds in the 2026 budget, in the total sum of \$334,367, to donate to the following organizations: The Brighton Legacy Foundation, The Boys and Girls Club, Colorado Legal Services, and Almost Home, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, whenever the City grants or donates to other corporate entities, such as a school district or other non-profit corporations, the City must make a finding of public purpose to comply with the State Constitution for these donations; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that donating to the non-profit organizations operating within the City or serving the residents of the City benefits the community, improves the availability of programs offered, and generally enhances the welfare of the residents of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Brighton, Colorado, as follows:

<u>Section</u> 1. The City Council approves the donations to The Brighton Legacy Foundation, The Boys and Girls Club, Colorado Legal Services, and Almost Home, Inc. as set forth in the 2026 budget for the sum total of \$334,367.

<u>Section 2</u>. The City Council finds these donations serve the public purpose of enhancing the quality of services and programs, benefitting the residents and especially those who have the greatest need, and improving the welfare of all those who live and work in the City.

<u>Section</u> 3. This Resolution is effective upon the date of its adoption.
