Background

- Currently use a shared RMS through AdCom where each agency shares the cost of the system, infrastructure, and staff.
- By agreement of the AdCom board of directors in 2025, AdCom will no longer be hosting a shared RMS platform for law enforcement agencies once all agencies have implemented their own platform.
- All partner agencies have either procured their own RMS platform or are in the process of doing so.
- Timely action to procure an RMS platform by Brighton PD is necessary to avoid assuming the full cost of the shared RMS.
- The current system has limited functionality.

Project Overview

- Replacement of current Records Management System (RMS).
 - RMS is the Core System for police reports, records, and data management.
 - Supports reporting, investigations, prosecution, evidence management, and information sharing.
- Current Data Archiving.
- Reliable integrations with partner systems.
- GOAL: Implement a modern, efficient, and sustainable RMS.

Staff Recommendation

Tyler Technologies, Inc.

- Most responsive and responsible proposer.
- Strong integration with Critical Criminal Justice Partner Systems.
 - eDiscovery, Municipal Full Court System, AXON, etc.
- Proven performance with peer agencies.
- Mature, configurable workflows that meet compliance requirements and are user-friendly.

Procurement Summary

Procurement method:

Formal solicitation advertised through BidNet Direct, resulting in 8 submissions, 7 of which have been deemed responsive.

Staff recommendation:

Accept Bid/Proposal 8, submitted by Tyler Technologies, Inc., as this Proposal has been deemed the lowest most responsive and responsible of those received.
