## RESOLUTION NO. 2025-39

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, APPOINTING REPRESENTATIVES AND ALTERNATES OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO CERTAIN BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

WHEREAS, boards and commissions play a vital role in municipal government; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Brighton appoints Council Members to boards and commissions after new Council Members take office and as needed throughout the year and seeks approval of such appointments by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-8-30(b) of the Brighton Municipal Code requires board or commission members to take an oath of office to support the Constitution of the United States and the State of Colorado, and C.R.S. § 24-12-101 requires the oath to include the laws of the state of Colorado and to faithfully perform their duties as a member of such board or commission prior to assuming such duties; and

WHEREAS, the following appointments will be effective for two years or until such time as another appointment is necessary; and

WHEREAS, Council Member Johnston resigned his position, leaving a vacancy on the Adams County Water Quality Association and a vacancy for alternate on the Lochbuie Sewer Board; and

WHEREAS, former City Council Member Clint Blackhurst was appointed to serve on the Metro Water Recovery Board for a two-year term ending June 30, 2025, and he is seeking re-appointment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. Former City Council Member Clint Blackhurst is hereby reappointed to serve on the Metro Water Recovery Board of Directors (formerly Metro Water Reclamation District Board) as the City of Brighton representative for a two-year term to end June 30, 2027.

<u>Section 2</u>. Mayor Pro Tem Peter Padilla is appointed to serve on the Adams County Water Quality Association and Mayor Pro Tem Peter Padilla is appointed to serve as the alternate on the Lochbuie Sewer Board for the remainder of 2025.

<u>Section 3</u>. This Resolution is effective as of the date of its adoption.
