A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, APPOINTING TRACIE MORRIS AS A MEMBER OF THE BRIGHTON HOUSING AUTHORITY TO FILL AN UNEXPIRED TERM TO JANUARY 2030

WHEREAS, the Brighton Municipal Code § 2-8-25 requires that City Council adopt a policy for appointment of members to City boards, commissions, and authorities, and the policy must establish the process for advertising vacancies, accepting applications, interviewing applicants, and appointing members; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved Resolution No. 2024-69 on August 20, 2024, and most recently adopted Resolution No. 2026-26 on March 3, 2026, updating the City Council *Policy for the Interview and Appointment Procedures for City Board, Commission, and Authority Members* (the "Policy"), which delegated the interview responsibility for certain Boards, Commissions, and Authorities and established the process for two City Council members to interview candidates for the other Boards, Commissions, and Authorities; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with the Policy, the Brighton Housing Authority conducted interviews for the open position and recommends appointment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that there are interested and qualified applicants and it is in the best interest of the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board to appoint new members in order for the Board to function and work toward the betterment of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, THAT THE FOLLOWING APPOINTMENT BE MADE:

PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY BOARD
