- Childcare expansion in 2005




Current State

- Gymnasium with three (3) pickleball courts, ability to run two (2) youth basketball games or two (2) volleyball games
- Walking track
- Five (5) office spaces shared with two (2) or more staff


Brighton Recreation Center- Gym Expansion

Task

- To address the growing demand for gym space for internal programming
 - Basketball, volleyball and pickleball
- Create more drop-in pickleball opportunities
- Address working conditions for staff sharing small workspaces
- Relocate the current cycle room to fit on the same side as the fitness/weight room




First Floor

Selection Process

- Firms were evaluated based on multiple factors including:
 - Experience, Project Approach, Technical Qualifications, Price & Terms
- Thirteen (13) firms submitted qualifications
- Narrowed it down to the top five (5) proposals
- Two (2) firms were asked to interview to provide more detail on their project approach and how they could contribute to this project

Selected Firm

- FCI Constructors, Inc
 - Determined to be the most responsive and responsible firm
 - FCI Constructors, Inc met or exceeded all initial criteria in the RFQ
- FCI Constructors, Inc demonstrated the greatest understanding of the project and scope of work

Procurement Summary

Procurement method:

After formal solicitation conducted through BidNet Direct, FCI Constructors, Inc was awarded a contract for pre-construction services for project 24-008645 Brighton Recreation Center Gym Expansion on or around August 20, 2024.

Accept the proposed Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) for Phase 2 – Construction in the amount of \$11,641,771 as submitted by FCI Constructors, Inc.
