City Boards and Commissions with Term Limits

- Parks and Recreation Advisory Board: 4-year terms, two terms
- Planning Commission: 4-year terms, two terms
- Sustainability Advisory Board: 3-year terms, four consecutive terms
- Historic Preservation Commission: 4-year terms, two successive terms (except professional members)

City Boards and Commissions without Term Limits

- Youth Commission: 2-year terms
- Housing Authority: 5-year terms
- Brighton Urban Renewal Authority: 5-year terms

Other Cities

- Thornton: no term limits
- Westminster: 2-year terms, limited to four consecutive terms. Upon reaching the term limit, may reapply and be subject to same process as new applicants; or may apply to serve one year as a member emeritus; or conclude their service at the end of their term limit.
- Commerce City: Most boards have a term limit of two consecutive 3-year terms. No term limit for Planning Commission.
- Northglenn: No term limits
