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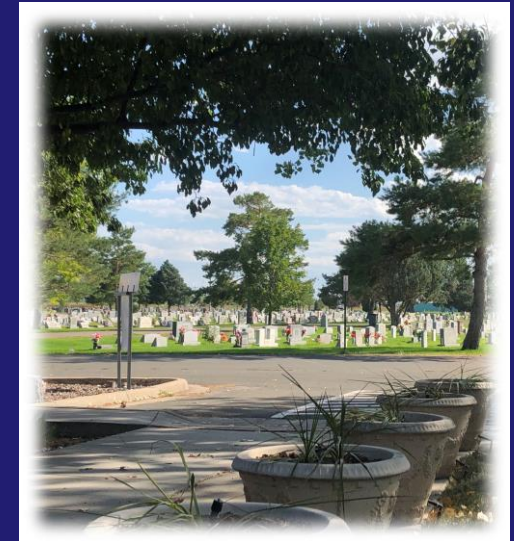

# Reason for Changes and Applicable Sections

- Section 2 – Definitions
  - Additions to improve clarity and accessibility with Table of Contents and Definitions
- Section 5 – Purchase of Lots
  - Applicable payment plan contract terms were consolidated for visibility and consistency
- Section 8 – Columbarium Niches, Ossuarium Niches, and Cremation Garden
  - Addition of Ossuarium Rules to existing Columbarium Rules



# Reason for Changes and Applicable Sections

- Section 10 – Disinterment
  - Disinterment Rules expanded to mitigate liability and limit potential exposure
- Section 12 – Foundations, Monuments, and Markers
  - Modifications to foundation, monuments, and markers to mitigate liability risk and preserve integrity of memorials and surrounding landscape.
- Section 13 – Decoration of Lots
  - Protect established trees and foster healthy development of new growth
  - Prevent lot owners from encroaching on adjacent spaces with decorations
