

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-44

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF LIGHTFIELD ENTERPRISES, INC. AND APPROVING THE PROCUREMENT OF THE TRANSPORTATION PRESERVATION AND IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FOR THE CONTRACT AMOUNT OF FIVE HUNDRED TWELVE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$512,575), AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton (the "City") desires to repair and preserve infrastructure, increase traffic and pedestrian safety, and improve drainage within the City by performing concrete maintenance; and

WHEREAS, Article 3-8 of the Brighton Municipal Code sets forth the requirements and procedures for purchasing supplies and contracting professional services; and

WHEREAS, the City published a notice inviting bids through its formal bid process for the concrete portion of 2025 Transportation Preservation and Improvement Project, Project # 25-009090 (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, sufficient appropriations exist for the Project; and

WHEREAS, Lightfield Enterprises, Inc. ("Lightfield") submitted a bid for the Project in the amount of \$512,575 (the "Proposal"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes Lightfield is the most responsive and responsible bidder to perform the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The proposal of Lightfield is hereby accepted.

Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, after consultation with the City Attorney is hereby authorized to sign the contract with Lightfield in an amount of \$512,575 for the Project on behalf of the City.

Section 3. This Resolution is effective as of the date of its adoption.
