

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-11

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AWARDING A MASTER PRICE AGREEMENT TO C&L WATER SOLUTIONS FOR UTILITY REPAIR AND CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR THE INITIAL NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION DOLLARS (\$2,000,000), AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE MASTER PRICE AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton (the "City") published a notice inviting bids through its formal bid process for Utility Repair and Construction Services, Project No. 25-000418M.2 (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, sufficient appropriations exist for the Project; and

WHEREAS, American C&L Water Solutions ("C&L") submitted a bid for the Project ("Proposal"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes C&L is among the most responsive and responsible bidders for the Project; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to execute a Master Price Agreement with C&L with an Initial annual not-to-exceed value of \$2,000,000 (the "MPA"); and

WHEREAS, Article 3-8 of the Brighton Municipal Code sets forth the requirements and procedures for executing master price agreements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Proposal of C&L is hereby accepted.

Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, after consultation with the City Attorney, is hereby authorized to sign the MPA with C&L on behalf of the City.

Section 3. This Resolution is effective as of the date of its adoption.
