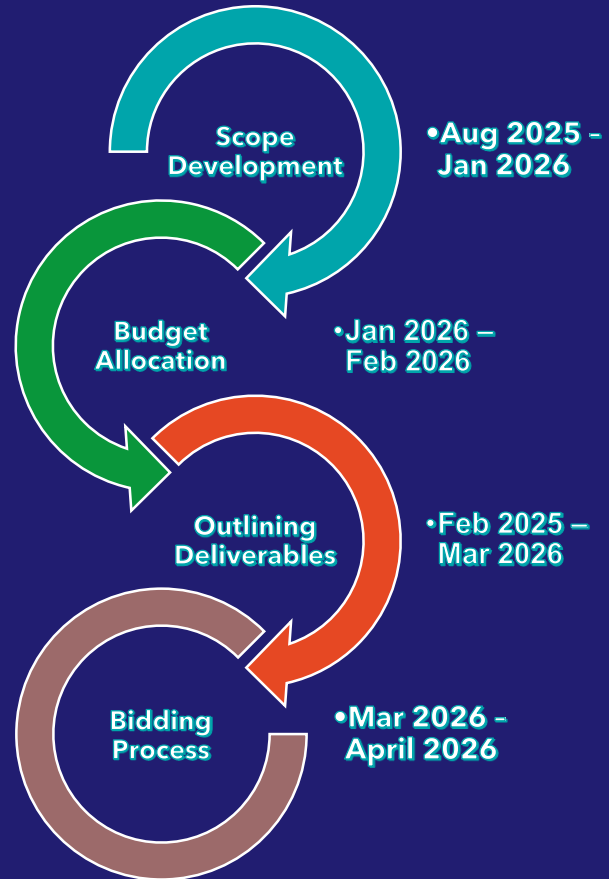
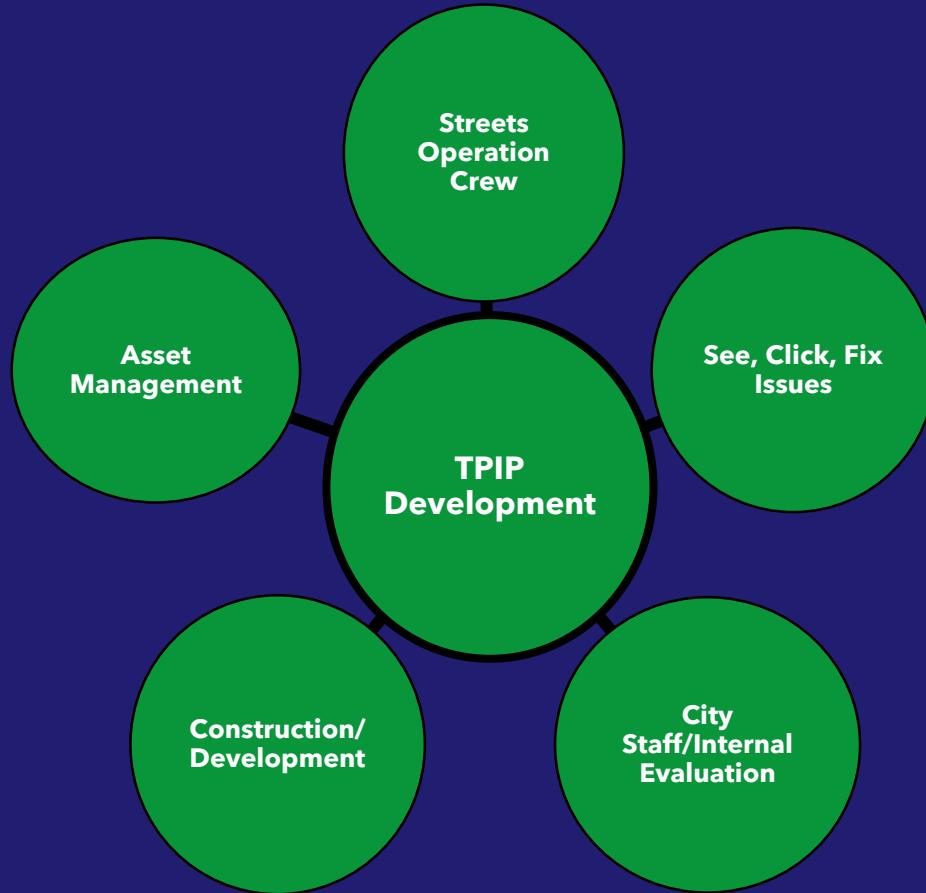

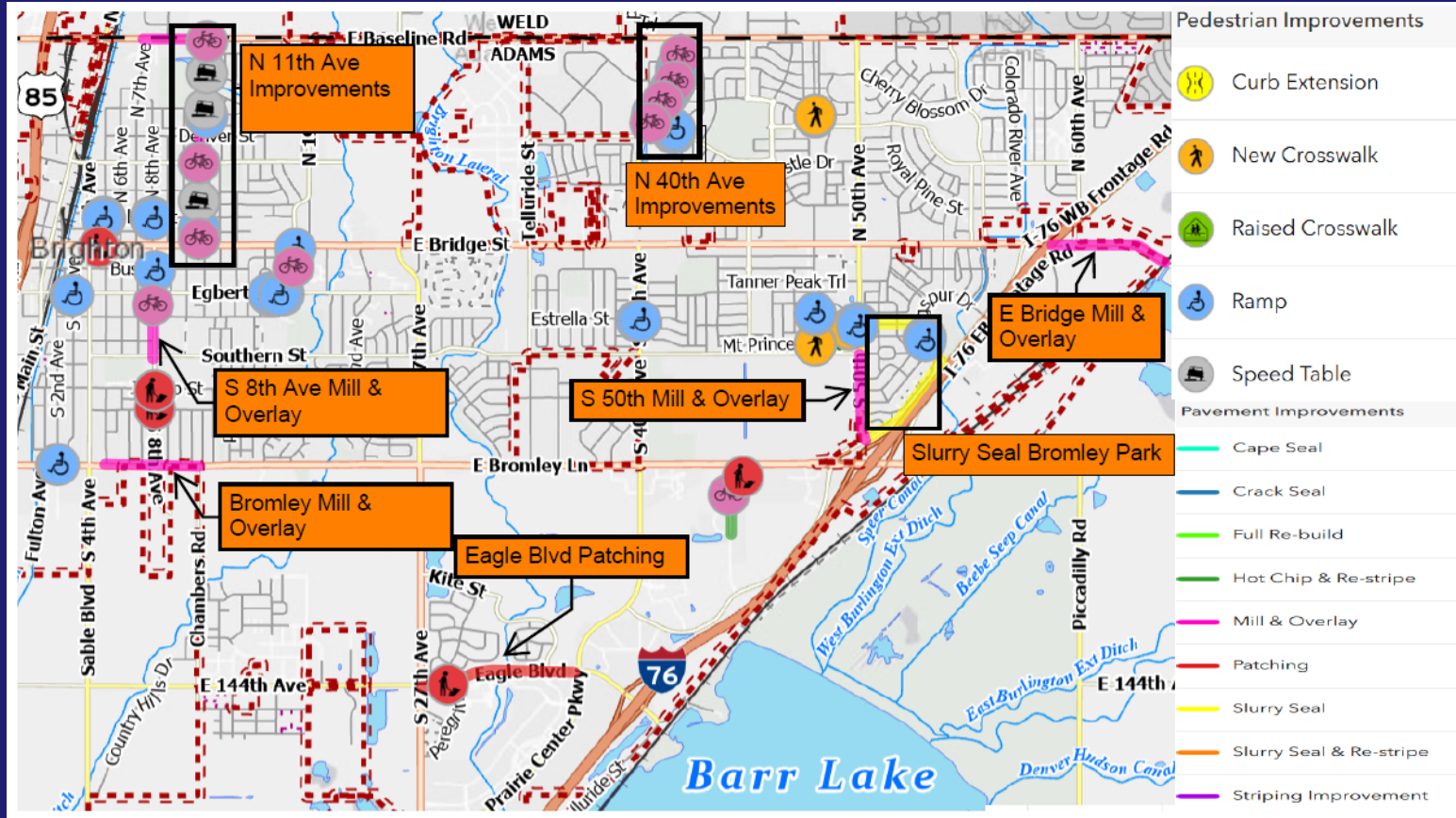

Procurement Summary

Procurement method:

Formal solicitation advertised through BidNet Direct, resulting in 4 submissions, 4 of which have been deemed responsive.

Staff recommendation:

Accept Bid 2, submitted by Asphalt Specialties Co. Inc., as this Bid has been deemed the lowest most responsive and responsible of those received, by providing a detailed schedule and timeline, competitive pricing, and a project approach that addressed the main points of coordination and concern.

Dollar amount of
Bids/Proposals received:

1. \$ 2,883,310.00
2. \$ 1,890,825
3. \$ 2,310,258
4. \$ 1,640,365

Dollar amounts have been rounded to next whole dollar.

Final Recommendation

- ✓ Award the Contract for pavement maintenance to ASPHALT SPECIALTIES CO., INC as the most responsive and qualified bidder in the amount of \$1,890,825.
