### **Purpose**

To provide Council with information regarding proposed utility rate and impact fee updates to be included in the 2026 rate study proposal.

### **Background**

Staff reviews utility fees and impact fees annually and partners with consultants for rate and fee studies periodically to ensure rates and fees reasonably reflect the cost of service provided. All fees are included in the annual fee resolution proposed to City Council as part of the Budget Adoption process.

## Focus – Storm Drainage A small fund with big needs

#### The Fund

- Generates revenues around \$3M annually
- Not a TABOR enterprise fund
  - Cannot borrow without voter approval
  - Can supplement with general or capital funds as available and allowed
- Storm Drainage projects can exceed \$10M and be necessary for other improvements, including road widening and residential development.
- Storm Drainage projects may be required for public safety and to prevent flooding of other infrastructure.
- There are potentially \$200M+ in Storm Drainage projects that the City will need to address in coming years.

#### Staff's Approach

- Conduct a new rate study that factors in all future capital needs as well as other potential sources.
- Consider storm drainage costs that are integral to other projects as part of those project budgets.
  - For example, Bridge Street Widening funded more than \$2M in storm drainage improvements.
- Consider comparability and affordability in rates, knowing that the fund will not be able to reasonably generate enough revenue to fund all projects.

<sup>\*\*</sup> Each single-unit residential account is one EQR, so this equates to \$3/month for a single-unit residential account.

<sup>\*</sup> Wastewater rates are charged by the processor (Metro Water Recovery or the Town of Lochbuie. The City collects fees on behalf of the processors. No Impact Fees are charged by the City for the Wastewater facility.

## Impact Fees – Background General Fees

2023 Study on General Impact Fees (Transportation & General Services)

#### Recommendations in 2024:

- Residential Increase Impact Fees with a phased-in approach.
  - (50% in 2025, 50% in 2026)
- <u>Commercial</u> Leave fees at existing rates as an incentive for development.
- <u>All</u> Apply inflation annually to avoid large corrections in the future.

#### The Funds

#### Water Utility

 Most recent rate study in 2023 with increases implemented in April 2024.

#### Storm Drainage Utility

- Most recent rate study in 2025.
- Previous study was in 2021 with no changes to impact fees implemented.

#### The Recommendations

#### Water Utility

Inflationary increases only

#### Storm Drainage Utility

- Residential Increase \$784 per Single Unit,
   \$372 per Multi Unit
- Commercial Increase of \$0.15/sq ft

In an effort to remain affordable, staff recommends forgoing the rate study recommended increases to Transportation and General Services.
