#### The Development

#### Ravenfield Senior Affordable Apartments


- East of S. 27<sup>th</sup> Ave. and North of Purcell St.
- Subdivided into two lots.
- Apartment building on Lot 2.



### **Ravenfield Senior Apartments**

Three-story, 46-unit walk-up apartment building.

- ★ Entrance off S. 27<sup>th</sup> Ave.
- Main building entrance, outdoor amenities, and parking.
- ★ Stormwater management facilities.



#### **Application for Impact Fee Reductions**

- Owner: Brighton Housing Authority (BHA).
- Representations made in application:
  - 26 units at max. 60% AMI.
  - 20 units at max. 50% AMI.
  - Residents restricted to min. 62 years of age.
  - Land use restriction agreement with CHFA.
  - The site is within a ten-minute walk of Sister City Park.
  - BHA is exempt from paying use tax.

#### **Requested Reductions**

#### The following reductions were requested:

Fees / Tax / Dedication	Percentage of Reduction
• Use Tax	100%
Park Related Impact Fee	100%
Transportation and Multimodal Impact Fee	100%
General Services Impact Fee	100%
Water Impact Fee	50% @ 50% AMI / 40% @ 60% AMI
City Wastewater Connection Fee	50% @ 50% AMI / 40% @ 60% AMI
Storm Drainage Impact Fee	50% @ 50% AMI / 40% @ 60% AMI
Parks & Open Space Land Dedication	100%

### **Staff Analysis**

- Applicant's representations have been verified to the extent possible.
- The requested reductions align with the Affordable Housing Fee & Dedication Reduction Table.
- Based on provided valuation and 2026 fees, estimated reduction = \$871,184.
- \$200,644 of which requires payment from the General Fund to the Enterprise Fund.
