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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF WELLS FARGO BANK, NATIONAL ASSOCIATION FOR A NEW SNOWPLOW FLEET FOR THE CONTRACT AMOUNT OF FOUR MILLION TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$4,200,000), AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the City of Brighton, Colorado (the "City") currently maintains its streets with a fleet of eight snowplows; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to acquire a new snowplow fleet in 2026, Project# 25-007 (the "Project"), since the majority of its snowplows were purchased in 2017 and, due to their lifespan and normal wear and tear, need to be replaced; and

WHEREAS, the City currently partners with Wells Fargo Bank, National Association ("Wells Fargo"), and due to the City's current relationship with Wells Fargo, Wells Fargo is able to procure and lease, with a purchase option, a new snowplow fleet to the City; and

WHEREAS, Wells Fargo can complete the Project in the amount of \$4,200,000 (the "Proposal"); and

WHEREAS, sufficient appropriations exist for the Project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 3-8-60 of the Brighton Municipal Code, "[t]he City Council may waive the formal solicitation procedure for contracts greater than one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00)...[if] such waiver will be in the best interest of the City."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Council hereby finds it is in the best interest of the City to waive formal solicitation requirements of Article 3-8 of the BMC by utilizing sole-source procurement.

<u>Section2</u>. The Proposal of Wells Fargo is hereby accepted.

<u>Section 3</u>. The City Manager, or designee, after consultation with the City Attorney, is hereby authorized to sign the contract with Wells Fargo on behalf of the City in substantially the form presented at this meeting, with such technical additions or revisions as the City Attorney may deem necessary, on or after January 1, 2026.

<u>Section 4</u> . This Resolution is effective as of the date of its adoption.
