WHEREAS, the City Council finds that Mr. Hoffman is qualified and should be appointed as the Special Counsel to advise the City Council for the protest hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. Corey Hoffman is hereby appointed as the City of Brighton's special counsel for the purpose of advising the City Council at a protest hearing and drafting the findings and decision of the City Council after the hearing.
