# Proposed Updates to Policy

- Addition of new boards and commissions: Sustainability Advisory Board, Downtown Development Authority Board
- Remove Board of Appeals
- City Council interview of applicants: Added Downtown Development Authority and Brighton Housing Authority
- Added Sustainability Advisory Board to boards that interview candidates

# Proposed Updates to Policy

- Anyone who interviewed within the previous twelve (12) months for the same Board or Commission for which they seek re-appointment does not require another interview, and their application will move forward for appointment.

# Proposed Changes to Policy

- Change required attendance at a meeting by an applicant to encourage attendance.
- Council member interviews: The City Council shall by majority vote appoint an interview panel consisting of one member from each ward. The City Clerk shall schedule interviews utilizing any two members of the panel, based on their availability. The City Clerk and/or the City Attorney may attend the interview. If an interview is scheduled and a Council Member is unable to attend, the Mayor may replace one panel member to conduct the interview.
