

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, APPROVING SUBMITTAL OF A REQUEST TO METRO WATER RECOVERY TO DETERMINE FEASIBILITY OF EXPANDING SERVICE AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AND SUBMIT SUCH REQUEST

WHEREAS, Metro Water Recovery (“Metro”) is a wastewater disposal district serving sixty-five municipalities and special districts across an 817-square mile service area; and

WHEREAS, any municipality is eligible for inclusion in a district with the consent of the municipality and the consent of the district pursuant to C.R.S. § 32-4-513(1); and

WHEREAS, the Town of Lochbuie wastewater treatment plant is reaching its full capacity and will need to expand to meet the growth of the Town and the area served by the City of Brighton (“City”); and

WHEREAS, the City desires to request a determination of the feasibility of Metro including within its service boundaries the portion of the City currently served by the Town of Lochbuie; and

WHEREAS, the City Council authorizing the submittal of a feasibility request and the terms and conditions upon which the service area expansion could be completed is in the best interests of the residents and businesses of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIGHTON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute and submit the request to Metro to determine the feasibility of serving the entire City of Brighton and the terms and conditions of the inclusion of this additional area.

Section 2. This Resolution is effective as of the date of its adoption.
